The Warehouse Associate accurately supports established processes for all incoming and outgoing materials and existing inventory. This includes the kitting and issuance of material for work orders as defined by the Planning Team, ensuring stock materials are identified for planned requirements.

- Implements assigned warehouse activities to ensure the efficient and economical utilization of facilities for storing and picking materials.
- Works independently to pick and pack orders.
- Using safe work procedures, opens incoming packages to unload and stock products.
- Completes assigned periodic cycle counts and escalates discrepancies in a timely manner. May also be asked to assist with root cause analysis for inconsistencies.
- Assists in the identification of slow moving or non-usable inventory using system records and product knowledge.

- Supports Production/Quality/Purchasing in return to vendor (RTV) of non-conforming materials. Tracks RTV material in support of production requirements.
- Executes the delivery of non-inventory receipts and inventory issues to the planned recipient.
- Completes daily cleaning, organization, and 5S tasks.
